PET PREPAREDNESS: KEY TIPS 🐾 🚜

HAVE IDENTIFICATION ON YOUR PET AT ALL TIMES

- MAKE SURE YOUR PET IS MICROCHIPPED
 - MICROCHIPPING ESTABLISHES LEGAL OWNERSHIP IF YOUR PET WAS EVER STOLEN
- ENSURE YOUR PET HAS A COLLAR WITH YOUR PET'S NAME AND YOUR CONTACT INFORMATION
- KEEP A CURRENT PHOTO OF YOU AND YOUR PET ON HAND

CREATE AN EMERGENCY PLAN

- BE AWARE OF LOCAL SHELTERS, BOARDING FACILITIES, PET FRIENDLY HOTELS NEAR YOU IN CASE OF EMERGENCY
 - ENSURE YOUR PET IS UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS
- INCLUDE YOUR PET IN EVACUATION/EMERGENCY DRILLS IN YOUR HOME
 - DESIGNATE SOMEONE IN YOUR FAMILY WHO WOULD BE RESPONSIBLE FOR EACH PET. CONSIDER THEIR FOOD & MEDICATIONS
- KEEP PET CARRIERS/CRATES IN AN EASILY ACCESSIBLE LOCATION

HAVE AN EMERGENCY KIT FOR YOUR PET 🔂

- 7-10 DAYS WORTH OF YOUR PETS FOOD, WATER, MEDICATION, LITTER AND/OR WASTE BAGS
- LEASHES, TOYS, BEDS, FOOD/WATER BOWLS, CARRIERS OR CRATES
- PET FIRST AID KIT
- PRINTED COPY OF YOUR PETS MEDICAL RECORDS
- INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR PETS MEDICATIONS, FOOD, ETC.







PET PREPAREDNESS: KEY TIPS

HOT TOPICS FOR SUMMER

HEATSTROKE:

 NEVER LEAVE YOUR PET UNATTENDED IN A CAR! TEMPS IN A CAR CAN RISE RAPIDLY, EVEN ON A MILD DAY, BE CAREFUL EXERCISING, AND ALWAYS CHECK THE TEMPS BEFORE GOING OUTSIDE. IT IS BEST TO WATCH FOR SIGNS OF HEAT STRESS: THESE INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, SEEKING SHADE. LIMITING MOVEMENT, GETTING RESTLESS, CHOOSING TO SIT OR LIE DOWN. UNCONTROLLED PANTING, NAUSEA, VOMITING, REDDENING SKIN, AND EXCESSIVE SALIVA.



HOT PAVEMENTS:

 THIS CAN BURN A PETS' PAW PADS. IT IS BEST TO WALK ON GRASS, OR USE BOOTS MADE FOR HOT PAVEMENT. HOLD YOUR BARE HAND ON THE PAVEMENT FOR 10+ SECONDS TO SEE IF IT IS SAFE. IF YOU CANNOT HOLD IT THAT LONG. DO NOT LET YOUR PET WALK ON IT!

SUNBURN:

• SOME BREEDS/FUR/SKIN TYPES ARE MORE PRONE TO SUNBURN. THERE ARE DOG SAFE SUNSCREENS OR UV BLOCKING SHIRTS, USE PET SAFE SUNSCREEN ONLY.



THUNDERSTORM/FIREWORK PHOBIAS:

 IF YOUR PET IS ON MEDICATION FOR ANY OF THESE. CALL AND GET THEM FILLED BEFORE THE STORM OR FIREWORKS! IF YOU FEEL YOUR PET NEEDS MEDICATION. CALL AND DISCUSS WITH YOUR VET.
